#### **April 4-June 1**

- Grant totals are announced to members on April 1
- Eligibility form goes LIVE March 1st
- April 4 Q&A Nonprofit Session
- Eligibility Forms due May 13th
- Grant application due June 1st

#### June 1- October 15

- Financial Review Team analyzes proposals.
- Members review applications and determine semi-finalists
- Site visits conducted
- Up to two finalists are selected from each Grant Review Committee

#### October 20 - mid-November

- Finalist prepare to present
- Up to 10 finalists present at Annual Meeting to the entire membership
- Membership votes are tallied
- Grant recipients are announced

Prepare to give a short, no technology speech to our membership at our Annual Meeting on November 28th

Grant recipients will sign a Grant Agreement, outlining all reporting requirements. An Impact 100 Jersey Coast Grantee Liaison will stay in regular contact with the organization. Interim and final reports will be reviewed and key details shared with wider membership.

#### **Mission Awards**

- Grants will continue to be awarded in increments of \$100,000
- To maximize impact of giving, excess funds will be divided among remaining finalists in the form of Mission Awards, up to \$10,000 each award

#### **Increased Opportunity to Be a Finalist**

 Review Committees will continue to choose up to 2 organizations from their group of applications to present to the broader Impact membership at the Annual Meeting

# **Nonprofit Eligibility**



# **Organizations** eligible for a grant must:

- Be tax-exempt under Section 501(c)(3)
- Be in operation as a 501(c)(3) for minimum of 36 months prior to applying
- Serve Monmouth County (MC), NJ
- Possess two years of financial statements
- Have a minimum annual operating budget of \$100,000



# **Collaboration**



- Shares Impact
   Grant Funding
- Only the LEAD org applies and details how much \$ will be passed through to the non-lead org
- Letter of Commitment from NON-lead

# **Partnership**

- No direct pass through of Impact funds to any other organizations
- Details of partnerships provided in 'Key Resources Required'
- No letter of commitment



# **Proposals** eligible for a grant must:

- Serve and benefit Monmouth County, NJ
- Use the funding for a new program, collaboration, an expansion, or to strengthen or sustain an existing program or collaboration
- Have a total project budget equal to or greater than \$100,000
- Plan to spend the full amount of the grant within 24 months





# We do NOT provide grants for:

- Debt reduction, endowment funding, interim or bridge funding
- · General operating expenses or overhead
- Grants to individuals or private foundations
- Partisan, legislative, or political activity

- STEP 1: ELIGIBILITY

#### COMPLETE ELIGIBILITY FORM

Deadline for submitting the Eligibility Form is May 13th, 2023. Eligible applicants are invited to submit an application form that is due on June 1st, 2023.

Approved applicants will be asked to complete the grant application form via Submittable.com, where applicants will be asked to create a user account before being prompted to complete the Eligibility Form.
