## HOW IMPACT WORKS

- 1 Gather a collective of women



- 2 Each woman donates \$1,100



- 3 Local nonprofits submit applications for high-impact projects



- 4 Committees review applications, perform site visits, choose finalists



- 5 Finalists present projects, members vote



- 6 Impact 100 grant(s) awarded



- 7 Grant recipients provide periodic progress updates to members

## YOUR IMPACT

Each member makes an annual **tax-deductible** membership donation of \$1,100. All of the membership donations are pooled together and turned into grant funding.

- \$1,000 is directly applied to the Impact grant fund.
- \$100 is allocated for membership activities, materials and Community Foundation of NJ\* management fee.

*\* Impact JC is a special projects fund under the CFNJ 501c3 umbrella*

## HOW WE HELP

- We raise awareness of the unmet needs of underserved populations in our community.
- We empower women to amplify their philanthropic giving and provide a forum for them to make a positive impact.
- We collectively pool our funds to develop new programs and projects, and to enhance and strengthen existing ones.
- We fund operating costs integral to the proposal in order to help to sustain nonprofit organizations.
- We partner with our grantees during the grant period (up to two years) to provide guidance, support and visibility.

## OUR GRANT RECIPIENTS

To date, our giving circle has awarded \$2.48 million to 28 local nonprofits.

We fund all types of programs from delivery of human services to capital project support that address a broad range of causes that touch every aspect of community life.

Some examples of the ways our collective funding has had a positive impact in our community include:

- Environmental stewardship education for underserved communities
- Wrap around programs to support and empower victims of domestic violence
- Family focused addiction recovery services
- Mental health support and suicide prevention
- Nutritional support and aid to local families with food insecurity
- Housing for at-risk and homeless youth
- Job training and employment opportunities for adults with special needs and developmental and intellectual disabilities
- In-school programs and resources for low income students and families
- Advocate services for foster children
- Education in music technology and business for low-income youth
