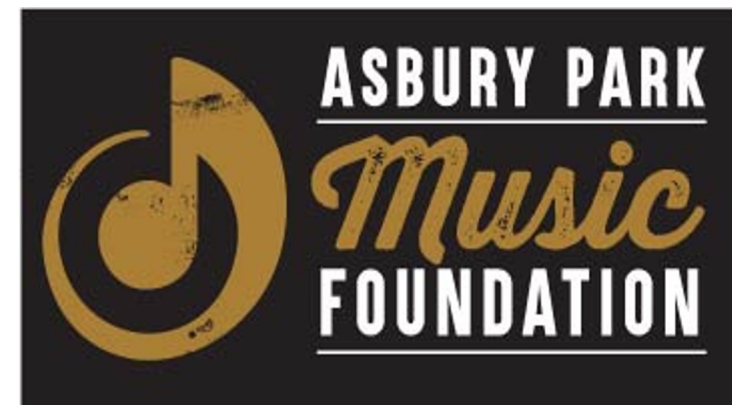

Mission Awards

Beginning in 2022, Impact 100 Jersey Coast included mission awards for finalists in the process. We are committed to continuing this for upcoming grant cycles.

Impact 100 is committed to continuing to implement Trust Based Philanthropy practices and partnership with local organizations. We continue to evolve and update our processes to align with the following commitments:

1. Grant Application

February - May

- Eligibility form is LIVE NOW!
- Q&A Nonprofit Session
- Grant totals are announced to members on April 1
- Grant application closes Monday, May 13th

2. Grant Review

June - Mid-October

- Financial Review Team analyzes proposals
- Members review applications and determine semi-finalists
- Site visits conducted
- Up to two finalists are selected from each Grant Review Committee

3. Grant Decision

End October - Mid-November

- Up to 8 finalists present at Annual Meeting to the entire membership
- Membership votes are tallied
- Grant recipients are announced

Grant recipients will sign a Grant Agreement, outlining all reporting requirements. An Impact 100 Jersey Coast Grantee Liaison will stay in regular contact with the organization. Interim and final reports will be reviewed and key details shared with wider membership.

Organizations eligible for a grant must:

- Be tax-exempt under Section 501(c)(3)
- Be in operation as a 501(c)(3) for minimum of 36 months prior to applying.
- Serve Monmouth County (MC), NJ
- Possess two years of financial statements
- Have a minimum annual operating budget of \$100,000.

Collaboration

- **Shares** Impact Grant Funding
- Only the LEAD org applies and details how much \$ will be passed through to the non-lead org
- Letter of Commitment from NON-lead



Partnership

- **No direct pass through** of Impact funds to any other organizations
- Details of partnerships provided in 'Key Resources Required'
- No letter of commitment

Proposals eligible for a grant must:

- Serve and benefit Monmouth County, NJ
- Use the funding for a new program, collaboration, an expansion or to strengthen or sustain an existing program or collaboration
- Have a total project budget equal to or greater than \$100,000
- Plan to spend the full amount of the grant within 24 months

What we do NOT fund...

- Debt reduction or operational deficits
- General operating support UNLESS a component of a proposal budget
- Requests that primarily redistribute funds to individuals
- Endowment funding
- Interim or bridge funding
- Partisan, legislative, or political activity
- Faith-based proposals which REQUIRE participation in activities of a particular faith, denomination, or religion in order to benefit from the proposals or program
- Capital improvements or renovations to the property for the grant proposals where the organization does NOT own or have at least a five-year lease (Permits must be secured by September 1, 2024)

Yes!

- The pool of applicants changes
- The review committee composition changes, even if the criteria is consistent
- The voting Impact membership changes, as does the environment we're all living and experiencing each year!
- Several of our finalists are repeat applicants and all of last year's grantees had applied multiple times.
